Jackrabbit Kentucky Bluegrass (Poa pratensis)

Jackrabbit Kentucky bluegrass (poa pratensis) is an ideal choice for turf managers, sports fields and home lawns. It also has excellent turf quality under all maintenance regimes (excels under low maintenance and in high stress environments).

Jackrabbit has a dark green color, which it retains into the winter and early spring green-up, and demonstrates strong wear tolerance. This cool season growth helps reduce poa annua invasion. It demonstrates high resistance to a broad range of diseases including summer patch, dollar spot, leaf spot, crown rust and stem rust.

SOWING RATE

Jackrabbit Kentucky bluegrass is sown 10 – 20 g/m² (100 - 200 kg/ha).

Broadcast to achieve an even distribution of seed, into friable, well drained fertile soils the seed should be covered with 6 – 12 mm of soil and kept moist until it establishes.
