



Lygia chewings fescue (CT4028) is a New Zealand bred chewings fescue that originated from a collection made in the south west of France. The plants were selected for adaptation into the New Zealand environment for improved turf quality and increased seed production. Lygia chewings fescue presents a vibrant bright green colour, strong winter activity and improved levels of disease resistance; in particular, Red thread.

The production of chewings fescue seed in New Zealand has a rich history dating back to 1880 when George Chewings, a farmer in the Rimu district of Southland, produced the first crop. This heritage underpins the development and adaptation of Lygia chewings fescue to local conditions.

SOWING RATE

 $20 - 35 \text{ g/m}^2 (200 - 350 \text{ kg/ha})$

BENEFITS:

- Vibrant bright green colour chewings fescue.
- Excellent density and leaf fineness.
- Outstanding year-round growth.
- Scored highly on disease resistance, particularly against Red thread (*Laetisaria fuciformis*).
- The overall turf quality score of Lygia was significantly higher than similar fescue varieties.

MAINTENANCE AND MOWING

Height: 25 - 75 mm

Fertiliser: 100 – 200 kg/N per year. Apply during periods of active

growth (September – November, March – May).

Mowing: Two times/week during active growth and remove no

more than 1/3 of the leaf per mowing.
