Key features:

- Will grow and survive on low-fertility soils
- Very competitive, good for weed control
- Good shade tolerance
- Very persistent
- Best suited to tropical climates

Perennial spring, summer, autumn growing grass suited to tropical climates. Argentine has a high tolerance to acid soils. Argentine has a moderate frost tolerance and is suited to well-drained light textured soils.

Maintenance

Maintain mowing height between 20 - 35 mm.

Sowing rate

80 - 100 kg per hectare.
