Egmont is a dark green colour, fine leaved browntop suitable for high quality, closely mown golf greens. It can also be used on golf fairways and tees, as well as longer cut surrounds and roughs. It is also a perfect choice to create a low maintenance quality lawn. Egmont has performed exceptionally well for all these purposes for over 35 years and continues to be an industry standard throughout the world.

Breeding history

Egmont was bred in New Zealand by Bill Rumball of AgResearch from browntop plants selected from golf greens in Australia and New Zealand. Superintendents were invited to send in plugs of the best browntop in their greens and several were selected as the parent lines along with three selections from greens at the Royal Melbourne Golf Club.

Sowing rate and maintenance

It is recommended to sow Egmont at a rate of 5 - 10 g/m² (50 - 100 kg/ha) when sowing as a stand alone or in mixtures with fine fescue.

For overseeding of existing turf 2.5 - 5 g/m² (25 - 50 kg/ha) is recommended.
